BMX EUROPEAN LEAGUE

- 2014 BMX European League is a series of 6 international events
 - Rounds 1 & 2 April 5th/6th Belgium / Zolder
 - Rounds 3 & 4 April 26th/27th France / Besançon (1 round for Challenge classes)
 - Rounds 5 & 6 May 17th/18th Switzerland / Grandson
 - Rounds 7 & 8 May 31st / June 1st The Netherlands / Klazienaveen
 - Rounds 9 & 10 June 21st / 22nd Great Britain / Birmingham
 - Round 11 July 11th Denmark / Roskilde
- Double points will be awarded in Round 11 for the Championship classes
- 9 races will count for the overall Ranking for Championship riders
- No minimum races to compete in order to be part of the overall standing

- 7 of the 9 BMX European League rounds count for the overall ranking
- No minimum races to compete in order to be part of the overall standing
- Points will be given according to European official grid (see page 19)

ALL UEC RACES

Passes:

- Chef d'Equipe (Head of country delegation) – Access to finish line
- Assistant to national chef d'Equipe
 - » 1 - 50 riders 2 assistants
 - » 51 - 100 riders 3 assistants
 - » 101 and over 4 assistants
 - » Host nation 5 assistants
- Each head of delegation will receive 4 extra passes (mechanic, physics, national coach...or any other person of delegation)
- Teams: teams registered through UEC will receive **one specific UEC pass per team per race** that will allow them to have free access to the surroundings of the track

ALL UEC RACES

Entry fees

- Challenge classes € 27.00 per entry
- Junior classes € 35,00 per entry
- Elite classes € 57,00 per entry
- Teams € 200,00 per team
- Register after the deadline (or on the spot with the agreement of the UEC Technical Delegate) results in double entry fees
- Entry fees to be paid in full by National Cycling Federation
 - By Bank transfer as mentioned in the invitation
 - In Cash by National Team Manager on site at registration control

ALL UEC RACES

Rider equipment :

- Short pants are allowed for all riders provided they are used together with knee and shin protection with a rigid surface that extends from the knee protection to fully cover the shin until just above the ankle
Nevertheless the UEC BMX Commission recommends for safety reasons the use of long pants
- Riders without a permanent career number **must not print** a number on the back of their jersey
- **New 2014:** Riders aged 13 and older are allowed to use clip pedals
- **New 2014:** All riders must wear country flags on both shoulders or a national shirt at all rounds

EUROPEAN TEAM RANKING

- **New 2014**
- The 9 first races of the BMX European League count for the ranking
- All teams have to register through UEC prior to the first Event of the season
- A rider can only be part of 1 registered team during the series
- 9 C1 races – 7 best results count
- The award ceremony will be held in Roskilde (Denmark), on Friday July 11th with Team coaches and minimum 4 riders
- The UEC Commission will award 3 trophies to the 3 first teams and one medal to each member of the team

RULES

- All teams register and pay a registration fee to the UEC at the beginning of the season (**deadline March 15st 2014**)
- Teams have to confirm their participation to the event (BMX European League) together with riders' registration
They have to pay a fee to the organizers of € 100,00 for a space of 6 x3 m for each team
- All classes are welcome : Challenge (20 & 24') & Championship
- 10 riders maximum in a team, but points to 4 riders registered by the Team Coach
- The list of registered riders will be sent out to all teams after registration deadline and Team Coach will have one week to decide which riders will make points, with possibility to change at registration control
- Points will be given according to European official grid
